Parking includes 19 commercial and 106 residential vehicle spaces and 88 bicycle parking spaces in 1 partial at-grade and 2 subterranean parking levels. There will be 7 units reserved for Very Low Income households. ZA-2013-1302(ZV)(ZAA) There is a hearing in June Discussion, motion and vote.
