To handle parking in their cities, Beverly Hills and Santa Monica have enacted "in-lieu" parking, a program where developers are given the option to pay a fee in lieu of providing some portion of the number of parking spaces ordinarily required by the city's zoning ordinance.

Possible Motion: That the Area 3 / Transportation Committees request the Board of HHWNC to formally request CD13 to commission an economic study analyzing the costs and benefits of implementing some type of in-lieu parking policy and solution in the Hollywood Regional Center. Motion and Vote

#### IV. Removal of Traffic Island: Las Palmas Ave/Yucca Street

Since the original balustrades were installed, more than 1500 units have been built in the area since 2010. Instead of calming traffic, it reduces safety by stakeholders making illegal U-turns to access their residences, or to reverse travel plans when Las Palmas backs up from Hollywood or Franklin during commuter hours, Hollywood Bowl events, and traffic redirection during premieres.

Possible Motion: That the Area 3 / Housing / Transportation committee requests the Hollywood Hills West Neighborhood Council request the removal of the traffic island by the Department of Transportation.
