Public comment is limited to two (2) minutes per speaker unless waived by the presiding chair of the committee.

Agenda items may be taken out of order. Motions may be taken on any agenda item. Any action taken would then be referred to the Hollywood Hills West Neighborhood Council's board (as a recommendation) for further consideration and action.

The library is located at the intersection of Sunset Blvd. and Detroit, which runs south from Sunset Blvd. Free parking is available in the library's parking lot, which is entered from Detroit. 6. Environment Committee & Parks & Open Space Committee joint project: Upper Runyon Canyon tree planting in partnership with Tree People, and with support and assistance from LA Recreation and Parks. Setting Dates and next steps. Possible motion, discussion, and vote.

Area 1: “wisdom tree” trail: The HHWNC board approved motion (18-0) at the June 21st meeting to recommend that Los Angeles City agencies to work together to find an alternate access point and trail to the “wisdom tree” on Cahuenga Peak that avoids direct access through residential areas as quickly as possible. Update of recent efforts and next steps.

The Open Space Work Group meeting June 7, 2017 Update: Recommendation of a stakeholder proposal that HHWNC recommend to the LA Planning Dept. to additionally hold at least three more Open Space Work Group meetings during hours when the public can attend, so that the public can have crucial input into shaping the City’s commitment to open space in the Los Angeles General Plan. Possible motion, discussion, and vote.
9. July 25th meeting recap of County Board of Supervisors meeting regarding the sale of an additional County owned parcel of open space land adjacent to the Hollywood Bowl.
