- Smith Park: \$2,5000 approved by HHWNC for new security lights requested by stakeholders in adjacent apartments to address safety concerns. Update and next steps (Rec & Parks, LAPD, LA-DWP).
- 3. Area 1: Cahuenga Peak ("wisdom tree") trail: After considering the initial results of the Dixon study, Area 1 stakeholders ask for expedited implementation of mitigation measures mentioned in Point # 2, Strategy #3. Specifically, the gate at the top of Wonder View, leading to the Wisdom Tree "Trail" should be permanently closed, as well as moving ahead with Option # 2, the establishment of a new trailhead further south along Lake Hollywood Drive near the Toyon Tanks. Finally, they would like to expand the area of study to include the establishment of a new trailhead from Forest Lawn Drive. (CD4, Rec and Parks).
- 4. Runyon Cyn. Park: Disclosure/Status of a Rec & Parks amendment to a 2016-approved memorandum of understanding (MOU) with Friends of Runyon Cyn. (FOR) Foundation for a three-year extension of the current term and categorical exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) – issuance of permits to use an existing structure of the City CEQA Guidelines for FOR activities. Possible motion, discussion, and vote. (Rec & Parks)
- 5. Park user input on safety issues at Runyon Cyn Park: Stakeholders have mentioned safety issues at Runyon Cyn Park that they would like to address (e.g. Recent Filming activities, Fuller Ave entrance retaining wall). Looking for community input on the overall safety needs/improvements. Possible motion, discussion, and vote. (Rec and Parks)
- 6. Runyon Cyn. Park Graffiti and tagging removal: Rec and Park protocol and interest in volunteer clean-up day. Possible motion, discussion, and vote. (Rec and Parks, LAPD)
- 7. Runyon Cyn. Park tree planting projects: Installation of new irrigation along the eastern hillside of Runyon Cyn has created a potential new water source to consider for next tree planting event on the East Trail ridge near the former McCormick estate tennis court. Possible motion, discussion, and vote. (Rec and Parks)
- 8. Runyon Cyn. Park Traffic Study: Jan 23rd HHWNC letter requesting discretionary funds for traffic and parking study (LADOT, LAPD and Santa Monica Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority). Update and next steps (CD4 Rep).
- 9. Blue recycle bin installation: With over 1 million park visits a year, stakeholder request to provide blue recycling bins for large amounts of water bottles at/near Fuller Ave gate and Mulholland entrances Possible motion, discussion, and vote. (Rec and Parks)

 - A. Runyon East Trail step land donation: Update on Bureau of Engineering input and remediation efforts required to prepare the parcel for City acquisition (CD4, Rec and Parks)
 - B. Runyon Cyn Opening/Closing Times: Plan by Rec and Parks to upgrade components for the main gates into the Park (Muholland, Vista, Fuller, and Solar Drive) with springs and timed locks. (Rec and Parks)
