# 94th Annual Academy Awards® Street and Sidewalk Closures

### 21 days Prior to Show (Sunday, March 6, 2022):

Close Orchid Alley from Orange Drive to Orchid Avenue from 8:00 AM to 8:00 AM on Saturday, April 2, 2022, except for emergency vehicles.

### 14 Days Prior to Show (Sunday, March 13, 2022):

Close north curb lane of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to south east corner of Orange Drive from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM Wednesday, March 30, 2022. (Except MTA buses until March 20, 2022)

Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 230 feet east of Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022.

Close east and west curb lanes on Orange Drive from Hollywood Boulevard to Orchid Alley from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM Tuesday, March 29, 2022.

### 12 Days Prior to Show (Tuesday, March 15, 2022):

Close all lanes of Hollywood Boulevard from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 16, 2022

# 11 Days Prior to Show (Wednesday, March 16, 2022):

Close north curb lane of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022. MTA to re-route bus traffic.

#### 7 Days Prior to Show (Sunday, March 20, 2022):

Close south sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022, except 8-foot pedestrian access.

Close all lanes of Hollywood Boulevard (with 20-ft Fire Lane) from the southeast corner of Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022.

Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard in front of the Dolby Theatre portal from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022. This is a complete sidewalk closure in front of the entrance to Awards Walk. Pedestrian traffic re-routed and emergency access available.

Close balance of north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022.

Close the pedestrian crosswalk, mid-block on Hollywood Boulevard between Orange Drive and Highland Avenue, from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM on Wednesday, March 30, 2022.

Close south curb lane of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022. MTA to re-route bus traffic.

Close (east/west) Hawthorn Alley behind El Capitan Theatre from 300 feet east of Orange Drive east to the "T" alley from 6:00 AM. to 6:00 AM on Wednesday, March 30, 2022. The remainder of Hawthorn Alley to remain open from the "T" east to Highland Avenue.

## 6 Days Prior to Show (Monday, March 21, 2022):

Close (north/south) Hawthorn Alley on the east side of the El Capitan Theatre from Hollywood Boulevard south 210 feet to "T" of east/west alley from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 30, 2022.

### 2 Days Prior to Show (Friday, March 25, 2022):

Close Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022.

### 1 Day Prior to Show (Saturday, March 26, 2022):

Close Orchid Ave from 60 feet south of Franklin Avenue to Orchid Alley from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022 except for residents, emergency vehicles, and hotel loading.

Close Orange Drive from Orchid Alley to Hollywood Boulevard, from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022 except for local residents, local business access, and emergency vehicles.

Close north and south sidewalk of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022.

Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022. MTA station to be by-passed from the last regularly scheduled train on Saturday, March 26 until the first scheduled train after 6:00 AM on Monday, March 28, 2022. Pedestrian traffic rerouted to south sidewalk.

Close west sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Johnny Grant Way south to Hollywood Boulevard from 10:00 PM to 9:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022

Close Johnny Grant Way from Highland Avenue to Orchid Ave from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022.

# Day of Show (Sunday, March 27, 2022):

12:01am March 27 – 6am March 28, Close:

- o Hawthorn Alley from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue
- o Orange Drive from Hollywood Boulevard to Lanewood Ave
- o North sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue (in front of closed businesses); No Pedestrian access. Erect bike rack.
- o South sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue from; Except for 8-foot pedestrian access. Erect bike rack.
- South sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard directly in front of the north-south running Hawthorn Alley. Erect fencing along the entire sidewalk. No pedestrian access across alley.
- o East sidewalk and curb lane of Highland Avenue from Yucca Street to Sunset Boulevard; except for 8-feet pedestrian access (south of Hollywood Blvd only). Erect bike rack.
- West sidewalk closure and curb lane of Highland Avenue (existing Johnny Grant Way to Hollywood) from Hollywood Blvd to Sunset Ave, with 8' pedestrian access. Erect bike rack and fencing.
- West curb of Highland Ave from Hollywood Boulevard to Johnny Grant Way to 9:00 AM Monday, March 28, 2022

4:00am March 27 – 4am March 28, Close

- o North and south crosswalks on Hollywood Boulevard at the Highland Avenue intersection.
- o Highland Avenue from Sunset Boulevard to Franklin Avenue
- o Hollywood Boulevard from La Brea Avenue to Orange Drive
- o Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Cahuenga Boulevard

Except for local residents, business access and emergency vehicles, close the following between 4:00am March 27 - 4:00 am March 28:

- o Hawthorn Avenue between Orange Drive and La Brea Avenue
- o Hawthorn Avenue between Highland Avenue and McCadden Place
- o McCadden Place between Yucca Street and Hollywood Boulevard
- O Yucca Street between Highland Avenue and Wilcox Avenue
- o Wilcox Avenue between Sunset Blvd and Cahuenga Boulevard

Restrict access on streets that end at or intersect Hollywood Boulevard and Highland Avenue at the discretion of the LAPD and LADOT.

#### In addition, we also request:

That the Bureau of Street Services be directed to deliver and install k-rails and furnish the necessary traffic control devices (barricades, cones and flashers).

That the Department of Sanitation be directed to vacuum pump the gutters on the west side of

Highland Avenue (2 gutters north of Hollywood Blvd, 1 gutter south of Hollywood Blvd) and Hollywood Boulevard (north and south curbs closest to Highland) at a time convenient to the Department of Sanitation between 3/14/22 - 3/18/22.

That the Bureau of Street Lighting removes light standards on Hollywood Boulevard to facilitate Production activity.

That the Bureau of Engineering reviews the specifications for the placement of the three, 24-foot Oscar Statues to be set in place on the sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard, and the media bridge that spans Hollywood Boulevard.

That the Department of Transportation be directed to (1) post "Temporary No Stopping" signs on the affected streets and provide traffic control personnel, as required; and (2) remove any traffic signal equipment that needs to be moved as part of the traffic management plan to facilitate production activity; (3) control the intersections at Sunset Boulevard and Highland Avenue, Hollywood Boulevard and Cahuenga Boulevard, Sunset Boulevard and La Brea Avenue to filter event-related traffic; and (4) be authorized to close additional streets for the purpose of traffic management or in case of an emergency.

Should unforeseen circumstances change the actual date of the 94<sup>th</sup> Annual Academy Awards, the aforementioned departmental instructions continue to apply.

### **Additional Conditions:**

Per the Los Angeles Police Department pedestrian access is restricted for public safety on Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Street. In case of emergency the Los Angeles Police Department may restrict pedestrian and vehicular traffic on any of the streets or sidewalks listed on this permit
