




### 2. Dorothy and Benjamin Smith Park

#### 3. Wonder View Trailhead Relocation











#### Relocation of existing trailhead entrance

- proposed: Lake Hollywood Drive approx. 100 feet south of Wonder View Drive
- Improves park access while removing tourists/non-residents from residential Wonder View Dr
  - Nightly locked gated entrance
  - Based on independent study by Dixon Resources (Griffith Park Report, 2018)
- DWP land (above underground Toyon Tanks)
  - MOU between DWP & private contractor
    - Contact and construction process can take 12+ months
  - Possible Action: Community Impact Statement in support of the project
